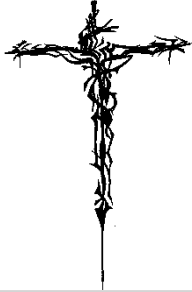

# Welcome to St Margaret's

**Welcomers & Sidespeople** (those with badges who greet you) are here to help - if you have any questions please ask them. If you are new please ask for a Welcome Booklet and if you would like, fill in the welcome card.

**If you are here on Sunday:** At our 9.00am and 10.45am services the children (from 3-11) will go upstairs for Sunday School/Kingdom Kids. There is a crèche area for under 3s upstairs and a crèche area for younger children in the foyer— please help yourself.
