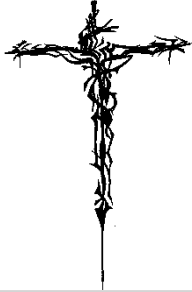

Welcome to St Margaret's

If you are here on Sunday: At our 9.00am and 10.45am services the children (from 3-11) will go upstairs for Sunday School/Kingdom Kids. There is a crèche area for under 3s upstairs and a crèche area for younger children in the foyer— please help yourself.
